

TUESDAY, MAY 20TH PRIMARY ELECTION:

Wednesday, May 7th through ELECTION DAY – A voter or their spouse **may apply for and receive a Medical Emergency Absentee Ballot** for the May Primary.

TUESDAY, MAY 20TH – PRIMARY ELECTION DAY

Please remember in a Primary Election:

- You are only eligible to vote for races that involve your particular party's primary and non-partisan races.
- You cannot switch party for the Primary; this would make you ineligible to vote in the Primary Election.
- If there is a race in your party's primary for County Commissioner, you are able to vote for all districts running, not just the one you live in. All County Commissioners run county-wide.
- All Constables and Justices of the Peace only run in the districts in which they live.
- Voters who are Non-Partisan or Independent are allowed to vote for Non-Partisan races. There is one race on the 2014 Primary Ballot.
